1 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

- 2 proposing a constitutional amendment appropriating money from the
- 3 system benefit fund for the purpose of returning system benefit
- 4 fund fees to retail electric customers.
- 5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Article VIII, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 7 adding Section 30 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 30. (a) On November 10, 2013, 90 percent of the
- 9 unobligated and otherwise unappropriated balance of the system
- 10 benefit fund account in the general revenue fund is appropriated to
- 11 the comptroller for the purpose of returning the appropriated money
- 12 to retail electric customers in the manner provided by general law.
- 13 The appropriation made by this subsection is not considered an
- 14 appropriation of state tax revenues for purposes of Section 22 of
- 15 this article.
- (b) On the date specified by Subsection (a) of this section,
- 17 the comptroller shall transfer the amount appropriated by that
- 18 subsection from the system benefit fund account in the general
- 19 revenue fund into a special fund in the state treasury outside of
- 20 the general revenue fund. The comptroller shall retain the balance
- 21 in that special fund and without further appropriation shall
- 22 disburse the money to retail electric customers as directed under
- 23 general law. The comptroller shall credit to the special fund all
- 24 interest or other earnings on the balance of the special fund.

- 1 (c) Money authorized to be spent out of the system benefit
- 2 fund account by an appropriation that is made by law before November
- 3 10, 2013, may be spent as provided by general law and in accordance
- 4 with that appropriation.
- 5 (d) The legislature by general law shall provide for the
- 6 Public Utility Commission of Texas to direct the comptroller to
- 7 disburse the money appropriated by Subsection (a) of this section
- 8 to retail electric customers beginning as soon as practicable, with
- 9 the entire balance of the appropriated money disbursed before
- 10 September 1, 2014.
- 11 (e) This section expires January 1, 2016.
- 12 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 13 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 5, 2013.
- 14 The ballot shall be printed to provide for voting for or against the
- 15 proposition: "The constitutional amendment appropriating the
- 16 system benefit fund for the purpose of returning system benefit
- 17 fund fees to retail electric customers as provided by the Texas
- 18 Legislature."
