A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment appropriating the system
- 2 benefit fund for the purpose of returning system benefit fund fees
- 3 to retail electric customers.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article VIII, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 6 adding Section 30 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 30. (a) On January 1, 2014, the unobligated and
- 8 otherwise unappropriated balance of the system benefit fund account
- 9 in the general revenue fund is appropriated to the comptroller for
- 10 the purpose of returning the appropriated money to retail electric
- 11 customers in the manner provided by general law. The appropriation
- 12 made by this subsection is not considered an appropriation of state
- 13 tax revenues for purposes of Section 22 of this article.
- 14 (b) On the date specified by Subsection (a) of this section,
- 15 the comptroller shall transfer the unobligated and otherwise
- 16 unappropriated balance of the system benefit fund account from the
- 17 general revenue fund into a special fund outside of the general
- 18 revenue fund. The comptroller shall retain the balance in that
- 19 special fund and without further appropriation shall disburse the
- 20 money to retail electric customers as directed under general law.
- 21 The comptroller shall credit to the special fund all interest or
- 22 other earnings on the balance of the special fund.
- (c) Money authorized to be spent out of the system benefit
- 24 fund account by an appropriation that is made by law before January

- 1 1, 2014, may be spent as provided by general law and in accordance
- 2 with that appropriation. The comptroller shall transfer to the
- 3 special fund described by Subsection (b) of this section the
- 4 unexpended and unobligated balance of the appropriated money that
- 5 remains at the time the appropriation expires and without further
- 6 appropriation shall disburse the money to retail electric customers
- 7 as directed under general law.
- 8 (d) The legislature by general law shall provide for the
- 9 Public Utility Commission of Texas to direct the comptroller to
- 10 disburse the money appropriated by Subsection (a) of this section
- 11 to retail electric customers beginning not earlier than September
- 12 1, 2015, with the entire balance of the money disbursed before
- 13 January 1, 2019.
- 14 (e) This section expires January 1, 2021.
- 15 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 16 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 5, 2013.
- 17 The ballot shall be printed to provide for voting for or against the
- 18 proposition: "The constitutional amendment appropriating the
- 19 system benefit fund for the purpose of returning system benefit
- 20 fund fees to retail electric customers."
