WHEREAS, The Senate of the State of Texas joins the citizens of Fort Worth in mourning the loss of Dr. Darrell Wesley Boren, who died January 9, 2013; and

WHEREAS, Darrell Boren was born on February 11, 1927, in Dallas; he grew up in Fort Worth and graduated from high school at the age of 16; Darrell served his country during World War II and later graduated from Texas Christian University; and

WHEREAS, He earned his medical degree from The University of Texas Medical Branch at Galveston in 1953 and became a highly respected family physician in Fort Worth; he went on to become certified in addictionology and served as medical director of CareUnit and Charlton Methodist Hospital's Addiction Unit until his retirement in 1996; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Boren was dedicated to his work as a physician and was committed to his volunteer work on behalf of citizens in the community; he was a devout member of the Masonic Lodge and the Moslah Temple Shrine; a longtime member of the Rotary Club of Western Fort Worth, he was awarded the Paul Harris Fellowship for his years of outstanding service; and

WHEREAS, An exemplary gentleman, Dr. Boren was a generous, kindhearted person who was respected for his leadership in the community and for his exceptional accomplishments; he was devoted to his wife, Marti Boren, and to his children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren; and
