**WHEREAS,** The company grew from its early emphasis on public works projects and developed into one of the nation's first integrated architectural and engineering design firms; today, it employs more than 500 design professionals around the world, and it has been ranked as the nation's 12th-largest architectural and engineering design firm; and

**WHEREAS,** The success of Page Southerland Page has played an important role in the growth and progress of our state, and it is truly fitting that this exceptional enterprise be recognized for its resilience, its longevity, and its many outstanding contributions to the community it serves; now, therefore, be it
