WHEREAS, The Hobby-Eberly Telescope is one of the world's largest telescopes and is one of many instruments used by the observatory to chart previously unknown areas of the universe; the Hobby-Eberly Telescope Dark Energy Experiment is slated to begin in 2014 and will collect data on 11 million galaxies and yield the largest map of the universe ever produced; and

WHEREAS, The observatory is also a partner in the Giant Magellan Telescope project, which will be the next generation of telescopes and will shed light on the origins and evolutions of galaxies, stars, black holes, and planetary systems and will explore the properties of dark matter and dark energy;
