

SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 641

WHEREAS, The Republican Women of Brazos Valley has made outstanding contributions to the Republican Party and to the community at large; and

WHEREAS, A local affiliate of the Texas Federation of Republican Women, the Republican Women of Brazos Valley is dedicated to advancing conservative principles and helping Republicans win elected office; under the able leadership of President Nancy Waldie, the organization's 178 members engage in grassroots political activism along with numerous initiatives for the benefit of their fellow citizens; and
