WHEREAS, Assigned to the 709th Military Police Battalion, 18th Military Police Brigade, 21st Theater Sustainment Command, out of Hohenfels, Germany, Sergeant Rivera died during an enemy attack in Puli Alam, Logar province, Afghanistan; and
