WHEREAS, The Senate of the State of Texas is pleased to celebrate the dedication of an Official Texas Historical Marker at Robert E. Lee High School on April 27, 2013; and

WHEREAS, The dedication ceremony for this distinct honor is being hosted by the Baytown Historical Preservation Association, the Harris County Historical Commission, and the Goose Creek Consolidated Independent School District; and

WHEREAS, Often referred to as "Baytown Lee," this venerable institution was founded in 1928 and is particularly noteworthy for its siting on the banks of Goose Creek and for its elegant architectural facade; and
