WHEREAS, In the year 2012 alone, abuse affected more than 57,000 Texans who are elderly or who are particularly vulnerable; elder abuse happens to men and women of all income levels and of all cultural and ethnic groups, whether they are in good health or are incapacitated in some way; and

WHEREAS, Self-neglect is involved in many of the cases investigated by Adult Protective Services in Texas, and it is our collective duty as citizens to reach out to those people in need; and

WHEREAS, The observance of Elder Abuse Prevention Month helps to raise awareness about the need to protect older adults and persons with disabilities from abuse, neglect, and exploitation, and it is fitting that a month be dedicated to supporting such a critical mission; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Senate of the State of Texas, 83rd Legislature, hereby designate May of 2013 as Elder Abuse Prevention Month; and, be it further

RESOLVED, That a copy of this Resolution be prepared by the Texas Senate in tribute to this solemn occasion.
