WHEREAS, Today, Trey is a resident of The Woodlands and is serving his community in a variety of ways; he has inspired many people with the speeches he has given that tell the story of his tours and of his service alongside his comrades on behalf of the country's safety and security; and

WHEREAS, A true American hero, Trey has joined those men and women whose courageous actions have set a lasting standard for others to follow and whose selfless patriotism and intrepidity are deserving of special recognition; now, therefore, be it
