Suspending limitations on conference committee jurisdiction, S.B. No. 1458 (Duncan/Callegari)

RESOLUTION

- BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the State of Texas, 83rd Legislature, Regular Session, 2013, That Senate Rule 12.03 be
- 3 suspended in part as provided by Senate Rule 12.08 to enable the
- 4 conference committee appointed to resolve the differences on Senate
- 5 Bill 1458 (contributions to, benefits from, and the administration
- 6 of systems and programs administered by the Teacher Retirement
- 7 System of Texas) to consider and take action on the following
- 8 matters:
- 9 (1) Senate Rule 12.03(1) is suspended to permit the
- 10 committee to change, alter, or amend text not in disagreement in
- 11 proposed SECTION 2 of the bill, in added Section 824.702(c),
- 12 Government Code, to read as follows:
- 13 <u>(c) If the annuitant:</u>
- (1) is a retiree, or is a beneficiary under an optional
- 15 retirement payment plan, to be eligible for the adjustment under
- 16 this section:
- 17 (A) the annuitant must be living on the effective
- 18 date of the adjustment; and
- 19 (B) the effective date of the retirement of the
- 20 member of the Teacher Retirement System of Texas must have been on
- 21 or before August 31, 2004;
- 22 (2) is a beneficiary under Section 824.402(a)(3) or
- 23 (4) or 824.502, to be eligible for the adjustment:
- 24 (A) the annuitant must be living on the effective

1 date of the adjustment; and

- 2 (B) the date of death of the member of the
- 3 retirement system must have been on or before August 31, 2004; or
- 4 (3) is an alternate payee under Section 804.005, the
- 5 annuitant is eligible for the adjustment only if the effective date
- 6 of the election to receive the annuity payment was on or before
- 7 August 31, 2004.
- 8 Explanation: The change is necessary to ensure that the date
- 9 used to determine eligibility for a cost-of-living adjustment
- 10 across different categories of annuitants under Section 824.702,
- 11 Government Code, is August 31, 2004, instead of August 31, 1999.
- 12 (2) Senate Rules 12.03(1) and (3) are suspended to permit
- 13 the committee to change, alter, or amend text and to add text on a
- 14 matter not in disagreement in proposed SECTION 15 of the bill, the
- 15 effective date provision of the bill, to read as follows:
- 16 SECTION 15. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b) of
- 17 this section, this Act takes effect September 1, 2014.
- 18 (b) Section 824.702, Government Code, as added by this Act,
- 19 Section 825.402, Government Code, as amended by this Act, and the
- 20 repeal by this Act of Section 1579.103, Insurance Code, take effect
- 21 September 1, 2013.
- 22 Explanation: The change in the effective date provision is a
- 23 technical change necessary to ensure that Section 824.702,
- 24 Government Code, adding a cost-of-living adjustment for certain
- 25 annuitants under the Teacher Retirement System of Texas, takes
- 26 effect in time to provide the adjustment provided for under that
- 27 section.
