R E S O L U T I O N

1 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the State of Texas, 83rd
2 Legislature, Regular Session, 2013, That Senate Rule 12.03 be
3 suspended in part as provided by Senate Rule 12.08 to enable the
4 conference committee appointed to resolve the differences on Senate
5 Bill 1017 (the funding for and administration of travel and
6 information operations by the Texas Department of Transportation)
7 to consider and take action on the following matter:

8 Senate Rule 12.03(1) is suspended to permit the committee to
9 change text not in disagreement in proposed Section 1 of the bill,
10 in added Section 204.003(b), Transportation Code, to read as
11 follows:

12 (b) The department may:

13 (1) enter into an agreement with:

14 (A) another state agency for the operation of a
15 travel information center; or

16 (B) a local government, including a commission
17 created under Chapter 391, Local Government Code, for the operation
18 of a travel information center that is located within the
19 boundaries of the local government; and

20 (2) issue a request for proposals to private or
21 nonprofit entities for the operation of a travel information
22 center.

23 Explanation: This change is necessary to allow the Texas
24 Department of Transportation to enter into an agreement with
