IN RE: HB307 by Farias (Relating to safety equipment requirements for certain cyclists; creating an offense.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Transportation Code to require bicycle operators to have a lamp that emits a white light in the front of the bicycle and a lamp that emits a red light at the rear of the bicycle during the 30-minute period before sunset or after sunrise; and would create an offense for a violation.
