IN RE: HB349 by Canales (Relating to electronically filing any court document in a criminal case in Hildalgo County.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend sections of the Government Code to require a court to implement the statewide electronic court filing system in certain criminal cases in Hidalgo County. The Office of Court Administration indicated no significant fiscal impact to the state judiciary is anticipated.
