**IN RE:** **HB397** by Larson (Relating to the transfer of extraterritorial jurisdiction between certain home-rule and general-law municipalities and annexation of certain territory by the general-law municipalities.), **As Engrossed**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend Chapter 42 of the Local Government Code relating to the transfer of extraterritorial jurisdiction and annexation of certain territory by municipalities. The bill would define "accepting municipality" and "releasing municipality," and would specify requirements for transfers and annexations to applicable municipalities.

**Local Government Impact**

Because the bill would not have statewide impact on units of local government of the same type or class, no comment from this office is required by the rules of the House/Senate as to its probable fiscal implication on units of local government.
