**IN RE: HB434** by Riddle (Relating to the persons authorized to take a blood specimen from a vehicle operator to test for alcohol concentration or other intoxicating substances.), **As Engrossed**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Transportation Code regarding procedures for drawing a blood specimen from a vehicle operator to test for alcohol concentration or other intoxicating substances; and would specify persons that would be authorized to draw a blood specimen.
