IN RE: HB434 by Riddle (Relating to the persons authorized to take a blood specimen from a vehicle operator to test for alcohol concentration or other intoxicating substances.), As Introduced

### No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Transportation Code regarding procedures for drawing a blood specimen from a vehicle operator to test for alcohol concentration or other intoxicating substances; and would specify persons that would be authorized to draw a blood specimen.
