IN RE: HB450 by Dukes (Relating to the designation of a state climatologist.), As Introduced

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Government Code, Chapter 470 to require the Governor to designate a state climatologist. The Office of the Governor and the Texas A&M University System indicate that any costs associated with the bill could be absorbed within the agency's existing resources.
