IN RE: HB525 by Aycock (Relating to the collection of data relating to military-connected students through the Public Education Information Management System (PEIMS).), As Introduced

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would require the Texas Education Agency to collect information related to the enrollment of military-connected students from school districts and open-enrollment charter schools through the Public Education Information Management System.

The agency estimates there would be a minimal cost associated with implementing the provisions of the bill.
