**IN RE: HB622** by Eiland (Relating to the report by the General Land Office to the legislature on the effectiveness of the coastal management program.), **As Engrossed**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would change the requirement that the General Land Office prepare a report on the effectiveness of the coastal management program from an annual requirement to a biennial requirement. Although requiring one fewer report from the agency may result in some cost savings to the agency, the savings is not anticipated to be significant.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
