**IN RE: HB762** by Guillen (Relating to restrictions on disaster remediation contracts following a locally declared disaster.), **As Introduced**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Business and Commerce Code to authorize the presiding officer of the governing body of a political subdivision to declare a natural disaster. Under current statute, the governor has the authority.
