**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would require a campus improvement plan to provide for a program to encourage parental involvement. The bill would allow a campus improvement plan to include goals and methods for dropout deterrence, prevention of bullying, and academic improvement.

**Local Government Impact**

School districts could incur costs for training materials if they adopt modifications to their campus improvement plans.
