IN RE: HB1030 by Burnam (Relating to the authority of a political subdivision to prohibit the sale of firearms on public property in certain circumstances.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Local Government Code to authorize a county, a municipality, or other political subdivision to prohibit the sale of firearms on property owned or controlled by the local governmental entity, other than the sale of firearms at a permanent retail store.

Local Government Impact
