IN RE: HB1144 by Strama (Relating to availability of certain information regarding energy use and efficiency of certain residential property.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Occupations Code relating to availability of certain information regarding energy use and efficiency of certain residential property.
