IN RE: HB1402 by Smithee (Relating to certain rebates and incentives for purchasing certain roofing services; providing a civil penalty.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Insurance Code relating to certain rebates and incentives for purchasing certain roofing services. Based on information provided by the Texas Department of Insurance, it is assumed that duties and responsibilities associated with implementing the provisions of the bill could be accomplished by utilizing existing resources.
