IN RE: HB1439 by Lucio III (Relating to the temporary sealing of certain complaints or affidavits on which arrest warrants are based.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

This bill would amend the Code of Criminal Procedure to add provisions which allow the temporary sealing of certain complaints or affidavits on which arrest warrants are based. The Office of Court Administration reported that it anticipates no significant fiscal impact associated with the bill.
