IN RE: HB2071 by Cortez (Relating to the issuance by reciprocity of a license to practice medical physics to persons who hold a license from the United States armed forces.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend Section 602.211(a) of the Occupations Code, related to the issuance by reciprocity of a license to practice medical or radiological physics to persons who hold a license from the United States armed forces. The Health and Human Services Commission and the Department of State Health Services indicate that the agencies would not need to modify the licensing process significantly if the bill is enacted and that any associated administrative costs would be absorbed within existing resources.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
