IN RE: HB2105 by Lucio III (Relating to municipally owned utility systems; authorizing the imposition of fees by a utility board of trustees.), **Committee Report 1st House**, **Substituted**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Government Code to authorize a municipality to acquire, purchase, construct, or maintain any property, including channels or bodies of water known as resacas, with respect to a utility system; a park; or a swimming pool. The board of trustees having management and control of a utility system would be authorized to impose and collect charges for services provided by a utility system.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
