**IN RE:** **HB2105** by Lucio III (Relating to municipally owned utility systems; authorizing the imposition of fees by a utility board of trustees.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Government Code to authorize a municipality to acquire, purchase, construct, or maintain any property, including channels or bodies of water known as resacas, with respect to a utility system; a park; or a swimming pool. The board of trustees having management and control of a utility system would be authorized to impose and collect charges for services provided by a utility system.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
