**IN RE: HB2153** by Callegari (Relating to the abolition of wind erosion conservation districts.),  
**As Introduced**

The fiscal implications of the bill cannot be determined at this time, due to a lack of data on the number of wind erosion conservation districts that would be subject to the provisions of the bill.

The bill would amend the Agriculture Code requiring the State Soil and Water Conservation Board to proceed with the dissolution of each wind erosion conservation district. The number of wind erosion conservation districts is unknown at this time; accordingly, the fiscal impact cannot be determined.
