**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would require that student codes of conduct specify the circumstances under which a student may be removed from a school bus.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated. School districts may be required to amend the student code of conduct to address behavior on a school bus. The placement of a student with disabilities receiving special education services would be determined by the student's admission, review, and dismissal (ARD) committee.
