**IN RE: HB2902** by Thompson, Ed (Relating to lost, damaged, or overdue county library property; authorizing fines; authorizing a civil penalty.), **As Engrossed**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Local Government Code to authorize a commissioners court to establish reasonable fines and regulations related to lost, damaged, or overdue library property. A person who violates a regulation would be liable for a civil penalty of not more than \$100. A county could bring suit in a district or county court to recover a civil penalty.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
