**IN RE: HB2961** by Huberty (Relating to the social security numbers of school district employees.), **As Introduced** 

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would provide that social security numbers (SSNs) of school district employees are confidential. The bill would require a school district board of trustees to adopt a policy prohibiting the use of an employee's SSN as an employee identifier for any purpose other than tax purposes.

## Local Government Impact

Administrative costs would vary depending on whether districts were using employee SSNs for any purposes other than for taxes. These costs could vary widely.
