**IN RE:** **HB3160** by Isaac (Relating to the eligibility of certain Texas Rangers for burial in the state cemetery.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Government Code to allow a Texas Ranger who has served at least 12 years as an officer or an officer who die in the line of duty, to be eligible for burial in the state cemetery.
