**IN RE:** **HB3672** by Fletcher (Relating to a requirement that members of the Public Safety Commission hold a secret security clearance.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Government Code to require as a qualification of service that each Public Safety Commissioner must have and maintain a federal secret security clearance. It is assumed the costs associated with implementing the bill's provision could be absorbed within current appropriations. The bill would take effect immediately upon a two-thirds vote of both chambers; otherwise, the bill would take effect September 1, 2013.

**Local Government Impact**

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
