IN RE: HB3729 by Coleman (Relating to licensing requirements for newly constructed assisted living facilities.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend Chapter 247 of the Health and Safety Code to permit the Department of Aging and Disability Services (DADS) to issue a six-month provisional license to a newly constructed assisted living facility without conducting a life safety code inspection before issuance of a license in certain circumstances. DADS anticipates any cost to implement provisions of the bill may be absorbed within existing resources.

Local Government Impact

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
