IN RE: HB3946 by Gonzalez, Naomi (Relating to the designation of the Officer Angel Garcia

Memorial Interchange.), As Introduced

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Transportation Code to require the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) to design, construct, and erect markers designating the interchange in El Paso between Interstate Highway 10 and Joe Battle Boulevard as the Officer Angel Garcia Memorial Interchange.

Section 225.021 (c), Transportation Code, specifies that TxDOT is not required to design, construct, or erect the marker unless a grant or donation of funds is made to the department to cover the cost. Based on the information provided by TxDOT, it is assumed any duties associated with the implementation of the provisions of the bill could be absorbed within the agency's existing resources.

Local Government Impact

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
