**IN RE: HJR39** by Burkett (Proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the denial of bail to certain persons charged with a violent or sexual offense after having been previously convicted of a violent or sexual offense.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted** 

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated, other than the cost of publication.

The cost to the state for publication of the resolution is \$108,921.

The resolution proposes an amendment to permit a judge from granting bail to a person that is in custody for committing a violent or sexual offense and who is determined to have been previously convicted of a violent or sexual offense.

The proposed amendment would be submitted to voters at an election to be held November 5, 2013.

## Local Government Impact

There would be some additional costs to hold a person in jail pending a trial; however, those amounts would vary depending on the number of applicable offenders in a locality and are not anticipated to be significant. According to Texas Commission on Jail Standards, the average cost for incarceration in a county jail is \$59.33 per day.
