IN RE: SB94 by Van de Putte (Relating to civil liability for compelled prostitution and certain promotion of prostitution.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would add Chapter 98A to the Civil Practice and Remedies Code relating to civil liability for compelled prostitution and certain promotion of prostitution.

The Office of Court Administration and Department of Criminal Justice indicate they could absorb any costs associated with the bill within existing resources.
