Introduced

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend Chapter 105 of the Alcoholic Beverage Code related to hours of sale and consumption of wine at a winery between midnight and 2:00 a.m. on New Year's Day. The Alcoholic Beverage Commission has determined that the bill would not result in a significant fiscal impact to the State. The bill would take effect on September 1, 2013.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
