**IN RE:** SB162 by Van de Putte (Relating to the occupational licensing of members of the military and spouses of members of the military.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Occupations Code relating to the occupational licensing of members of the military and spouses of members of the military.

Based on the information provided by the Department of Licensing and Regulation, this analysis assumes that duties and responsibilities associated with implementing the provisions of the bill could be accomplished by utilizing existing resources.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
