IN RE: SB194 by West (Relating to ingress and egress for access by emergency vehicles and for use during evacuations in certain new residential subdivisions.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Local Government Code to require municipalities and counties to adopt infrastructure standards requiring at least two means of ingress and egress for use by emergency vehicles during evacuations for residential subdivisions that are subdivided into 1,000 or more lots in the unincorporated area of a county.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
