**IN RE: SB350** by Williams (Relating to the storage of certain imported alcoholic beverages.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Alcoholic Beverage Code to modify the definition of an entity that is eligible to be issued a manufacturer's agent's warehousing permit. The Alcoholic Beverage Commission has determined that the bill would not result in a significant fiscal impact to the State. The bill would take effect on September 1, 2013.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
