IN RE: SB357 by Hinojosa (Relating to the issuance of protective orders for certain sexual, stalking, and trafficking offenses.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would add sexual abuse and trafficking to the list of offenses that would make a victim eligible for a protective order.
