IN RE: **SB408** by Carona (Relating to the confidentiality of certain complaints to and investigations by the Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Occupations Code relating to the confidentiality of certain complaints to and investigations by the Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation (TDLR).

Based on information provided by TDLR, it is assumed that duties and responsibilities associated with implementing the provisions of the bill could be accomplished by utilizing existing resources.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
