**IN RE: SB428** by Nelson (Relating to background and criminal history checks for parents or other relatives of children in residential child-care facilities.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would modify Human Resources Code, Chapter 42, to exempt child care facilities from submitting required information under certain conditions if the department has a recent background or criminal history check on file for the desired parties.

The Department of Family and Protective Services does not anticipate any significant fiscal impact as a result of implementing the provisions of the bill.

**Local Government Impact**

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
