**IN RE:** SB524 by Rodríguez (Relating to a study regarding the prohibition of dairy farming in certain areas of the state.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would require the Texas Animal Health Commission (TAHC) to conduct a study regarding the current risk level of bovine tuberculosis. This estimate assumes the agency could implement the provisions of the bill within existing resources and no significant fiscal impact to the state is anticipated.
