**IN RE:** **SB870** by Van de Putte (Relating to marketing items provided by manufacturers, wholesalers, and distributors of alcoholic beverages to retailers or consumers.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Alcoholic Beverage Code relating to marketing items provided by manufacturers, wholesalers, and distributors of alcoholic beverages to retailers or consumers. The Alcoholic Beverage Commission has determined that the bill would not result in a significant fiscal impact to the State. The bill would take effect on September 1, 2013.
