**IN RE: SB1109** by Deuell (Relating to suspending public school accountability ratings and certain interventions and sanctions for the 2012-2013 school year.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would suspend the assignment of accreditation statuses and performance ratings for campuses and school districts for the 2012-13 school year. Based on the analysis of the Texas Education Agency, the duties and responsibilities associated with implementing the provisions of the bill could be accomplished by utilizing existing resources.
