**IN RE: SB1191** by Davis (Relating to the care provided to a sexual assault survivor by a health care facility.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend Chapter 323 of the Health and Safety Code, related to the care provided to a sexual assault survivor by a health care facility. The Department of State Health Services (DSHS) indicates that the agency would absorb costs associated with updating health facility hospital rules if the bill were enacted.

**Local Government Impact**

There may be an fiscal impact to certain local health facilities as a result of implementing provisions of the bill, but it is not expected to be significant.
